Stars and Garters Consignment Terms

Stars and Garters' current consignment ratio is 70/30, increasing to 60/40 on August 30, 2008.

Stars and Garters is the consignee, the agent who sells your item(s) for you.

You are the consignor, who places your item(s) for sale in our gallery.

You pay us a portion of the proceeds from the sale.

Payment is not made until and unless the item actually sells (we, the consignee, write you a check for your portion once your item sells because we handle the transaction and accept the customer's money, process their credit card, etc).

We, the consignee, pay (6.6%) on each sold item to the Utah State Tax Commission prior to cutting your check.

We, the consignee and consignor, split the cost of the sales tax at the above conignment ratio.

We will call you, the consignor, as a courtesy to let you know if a large or high value item has sold.

Checks are cut and mailed out on the first of each month for any items sold in during the prior month. No exceptions and no advances. If you want us to hold your check so you can pick it up in person, you must call at least 3 days in advance. You retain the title to your item at all times, and you can end the arrangement at any time by requesting return of the item. If three months pass and the item still doesn't sell, you can either reclaim the item, or if you don't reclaim it and one more month passes, we will dispose of the item by either placing it in a good home, sending it off to rental stock, or donating it to charity. It is your obligation and responsibility as the consignor to keep track of the agreed dates.

If the item hasn't sold after one month, its price is automatically reduced by 10%. After two months, it drops another 10%, and after three months, the price drops a final 10%.

You must designate how your costume or accessory item is to be handled in one of three ways:

'for sale only'

'for rental only'

'rent and/or sell the item'

If you bring us a costume or accessory and give us permission to use it as a rental item, the consignment rate is 40/60 (40% to the consignor and 60% to the consignee -- it takes a lot of labor hours, staff time and fuss to handle rentals).

All jewelry falls into the "for sale only" category unless an item is something exceptionally durable, theatrical, etc.

All items you bring must be newly made OR if they've been worn previously they must be clean, machine washed and/or dry cleaned and in good condition. No exceptions. If you are bringing in masks, wigs, headdresses, hats, vintage or vintage-looking used shoes and boots, make sure these are clean, too. We can help freshen these up and disinfect them before they are put on display.

We are diligent, honest and organized. Even though we have insurance and security measures in place, you, the consignor, agree to hold us harmless and forfeit any claim on your item(s) in the event of a fire, flood, earthquake, natural disaster, theft or other loss.

I have read and I understand the consignment terms above plus the information about how prices are set. I authorize the agents of Stars and Garters to sell the attached item for me, for the agreed upon pricing and percentage fees as indicated.
